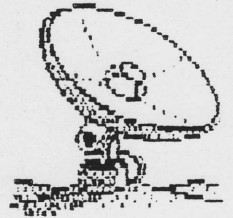

A prize draw will decide the winner of a seven day trip to GLASGOW Scotland, and will include return air fares for two people from the winners country of origin to Glasgow, (Donated by the Scottish Tourist Board), Hotel accommodation for the winner and a guest in Glasgow (Donated by the Great Glasgow Tourist Office), and complimentary tickets to events taking place in Glasgow during the winners stay. (Donated by the Glasgow 1990 Festivals Office). A secondary "Flying Scotsman" prize of 2 x 7 Day Freedom of Scotland Rover Tickets, (Donated by ScotRail) will be offered to a winning entrant and partner who intend visiting Scotland during 1990.

Amateur Radio Clubs in the Greater Glasgow Area have joined forces into celebrating GLASGOW 1990 Cultural Capital of Europe. Special event call signs will be activated from club premises and cultural events during the year. The main callsign for GLASGOW 1990 is:-

**GB6CC** (Golf Bravo Six Cultural Capital)

Call Signs at other special events:-

**GB8CA, CB, CC, CD, CE, CF, CG, CH, CI, CJ, CK, CL, CM, CN, CO, CP, CQ, CR, CS, CT, CU, CV, CW, CX, CY** and **GB8CZ**. Other class B calls in use **GB1CCE, GB6CCE** and **GB8CCE**.

#### HOW TO ENTER THE DRAW:

One contact with **GM90CC**, on any band and any mode, is mandatory plus any other four contacts with any of the above quoted clubs or special event stations. Send your **QSL** for **GM90CC** contact only, via the **GM** Bureau or Direct to PO Box 599, Glasgow, G1 1EW, Scotland. Quote the other four stations you have contacted on your **GM90CC** **QSL** card. Please do not **QSL** individual **GB** call signs involved in this event unless requested to do so by the station.

**THE DRAW FOR THE MAIN PRIZE WILL TAKE PLACE ON 1st May 1990.**

If you wish your **QSL** card to be entered for the secondary prize draw, please mark "Flying Scotsman" on your **QSL** card. This draw will take place on 1st June 1990.
