The Secretary of State gives notice pursuant to section 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 that he varies the terms of the Amateur Radio Licence with the call sign GM4 AGG (the Licence) held by the Licensee named above on behalf of the Society named above to permit him to use the station set forth above as a special event station.

This Notice is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) the call sign CM90CC is assigned to the Licensee and Clause 7(1) of the Licence shall be varied accordingly;
- (ii) simultaneous operation on any of the frequency bands authorised in the Licence is permitted only when the call sign GM90CC is used;
- (iii) greetings messages may be passed in accordance with sub-clause 1(4) of the Licence by non-licensed persons in the presence and under the direct supervision of the Licensee who must operate the transmitter and identify the Station and Clause 1(8) of the Licence shall be varied accordingly subject as follows:
 - (a) such messages must not exceed two minutes in duration;
 - (b) one person may pass only one such message to each station with which the station is in contact;
 - (c) consideration must not be demanded either directly or indirectly for the passing of such messages; and
 - (d) such messages may be sent and received only by stations within the United Kingdom except that international greetings messages may be passed from the station to stations in the United States of America, Canada, the Falkland Islands, and Pitcairn Island;
 - (iv) Clause 8(1) of the Licence shall be varied to require additionally that this Notice be available for inspection at any or all reasonable times;
